## German Investment Newsletter Fresenius Medical Care Selects Lebanon Valley Pennsylvania For Expansion

Fresenius Medical Care, a German owned medical instrument company, is moving into a new 124,000 square foot climate controlled building in Hawk Acres Enterprise Place, a business park developed by the Lebanon Valley Economic Development Corporation in Lebanon County Pennsylvania, U.S.

The company is making a \$7 million investment at the facility and plans to employ 65.

Fresenius Medical Care is the first occupant in the 120 acre business park opened by the Lebanon Valley Economic Development Corporation a year ago.

Nearby German owned neighbors in the adjacent Lebanon Valley Business Park are Schott Pharmaceutical and Regupol America.
