- Concerning educational attainment, **15.5% of Lebanon County, PA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.0% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.0% below the national average).









Unemployment by Ethnicity




























Top Industry Employment Concentration






