- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 3.3% since 2017, growing by 4,538. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2022 and 2027, adding 4,690.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 2.2% in Lebanon County, PA from 55,958 to 57,211. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 1.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 64.0% to 64.8% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.3% of Lebanon County, PA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.5% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Federal Government, Civilian, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).







Unemployment by Gender








Population Trends





Lebanon County, PA had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 2.60%, decreasing from 3.89% 5 years before.














Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Earnings


